Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Matriculation Certificate (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 08.07.1998 whereas petitioner No.2 has placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-3) depicting his date of birth as 28.04.1997. They have also moved a representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ambala, Haryana (Annexure P-6) for protection of their life and liberty.

Notice of motion only qua respondents No.1 to 3-State.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Himmat Singh, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State. Copy of the paper book has been supplied.

Mr. S.S.Chakkal, Advocate has entered appearance on behalf of the parents and states that they have met their daughter and have no intention of harming them.

Be that as it may, without adverting to the merits of the controversy and certifying the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ambala to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-6).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
