The grievance of the petitioner is that his paternal aunt (Bua) died on 16.12.2018. Her death was caused by injuries inflicted by the accused persons and although the statement of the complainant-petitioner was recorded by the police, no action is being taken against the accused persons. A written representation dated 2.2.2019 (Annexure P-5) has also been submitted but still the police has neither registered an FIR nor taken any further action.
