ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.96 dated 10.10.2018, registered under Sections 306/506 IPC, at Police Station Rajasansi, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that husband of the complainant had committed suicide as the petitioner and others had not made him the payment with regard to their business dealings.

This Court, by the order dated 12.03.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and it

was also directed that in case the petitioners does not pay the due amount as recorded in the ledger record, he would be arrested.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from Inspector Amarjit Singh, states the petitioner has joined investigation and has also paid the amount due as per the ledger record.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 12.03.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
