Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.6 dated 24.01.2019 registered under Sections 498-A/34 of IPC at Police Station Kahnuwan, District Gurdaspur.

Vide order dated 09.05.2019, petitioner was ordered to be released on interim bail, however, subject to the terms and conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from petitioner-Palvinder Singh who is present in the Court, states that the parties are staying together as husband and wife.

Complainant is also present in the Court and she has duly been recognized by the petitioner. Learned counsel for the complainant, on instructions from the complainant, states that she is staying with the petitioner for the last about 1 month.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforesaid fact.

In view of above, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 09.05.2019 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
