The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in respect of a case registered vide FIR No.277 dated 30.11.2018 at Police Station Lambi, District Sri Muktsar Sahib under Section 15 of NDPS Act, on the allegation that he was found in possession of 5 Kilograms of '*poppy husk*'.

The learned State counsel has opposed the petition on the ground that the petitioner is involved in four other identical cases.

I have considered the aforesaid submissions.

The petitioner, as of now, has been behind bars since the last more than three months. Bearing in mind the aforesaid custody period and the nature and quantity of the contraband recovered, in my opinion, it is a fit case for grant of bail. The petition, as such, is accepted and the petitioner

Tarsem Singh is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The present petition stands accepted accordingly.
