The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Narender in case FIR No.34 dated 06.04.2018, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 363 and 366 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC') (Sections 376, 366-A IPC and Section 6 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act added later on and Section 366 IPC was deleted), at Police Station Moohana, District Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel has submitted that although prosecutrix as well as her mother have been examined but they did not support the case of the prosecution.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the prosecutrix in her statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C. has given specific role to the petitioner.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long

time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the court.
