Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that non-bailable warrants of arrest have been issued against the petitioner for 8.4.2019, after the report of the Chemical Examiner was received. During the period the petitioner was on interim bail, there is no allegation that she has violated any conditions thereof.

The petitioner is a mother of five children and her husband is not living with her. There is no other case under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, pending against the petitioner and, therefore, her incarceration is not justified.

Notice of motion.

Mr. A.S.Gill, learned Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice. Let two copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court on or before 14.3.2019 and seek regular bail. In case, such an

application is filed, the trial Court is directed to allow the same, subject to its satisfaction.

In the meantime, arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed.
