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**MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J (ORAL)**

Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C') for directing the respondents no.1 to 3 for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioners and to take action against respondents no.4 to 14 as they had taken away his wife namely Ramandeep Kaur – respondent no.5.

On 23.01.2019, this Court had passed the following order:-

*“It is specifically stated by learned counsel for the petitioner that the wife of the petitioner namely, Ramandeep Kaur-respondent No.5 has been kidnapped by Mukha Singh-respondent No.7, but there is no averments in the present petition.*

*Respondent No.5 will remain present in person on the next date of hearing before this Court.*

*It is made clear that, in case the assertion is found to be incorrect, this petition would be liable to be dismissed with exemplary costs. Adjourned to 25.01.2019.”*

In terms of the above said order, respondent no.5 is present in the Court, identified by ASI GurnamSingh and states that she is residing

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with her sister namely Manpreet Kaur, resident of Village Burj Sidhwar, Sri Muktsar Sahib at her own and there is no pressure from any corner whatsoever including respondent no.7. Thus, the assertion of the petitioner that his wife i.e respondent no.5 has been taken away by the private respondents is without any basis.

In view of the above, this Court has no option except to dismiss the petition with costs of ₹15,000/-, to be paid to respondent no.5 through demand draft within four weeks from today and photocopy of the same be sent to the Registry of this Court. In case of non compliance, the matter be put up again after six weeks.

Ordered accordingly.
