Petitioners herein seek issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari directing the respondent to fix his pay in the revised scales as per Punjab Civil Services (Revised Pay) (Third Amendment) Rules, 1990 as adopted by the Board in their 131st meeting held on 25.08.1995.

Learned counsel for the respondent points out that the respondent-Corporation has since been wound up by the State of Punjab and in all likelihood the petitioner would have lost interest in prosecuting the present petition against the erstwhile corporation. Even otherwise, I am of the opinion by sheer efflux of time, the relief sought by the petitioners at the time of filing the present petition may have been rendered infructuous.

In the premise, writ petition is dismissed as infructuous with liberty to the petitioners to move an appropriate application, in case, any cause of action still survives.
