AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (ORAL)

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 21.09.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 20994 of 2017. Operational part of the order is reproduced below:-

“ In view of the above, the present writ petition is allowed and directions is being given to the respondents to regularize the petitioner w.e.f. the date when his juniors have been regularized as per information given in Annexure P-14 under RTI Act within a period of 4 weeks on receipt of the order of this Court. Petitioner has been reinstated on 22.11.2013 and prior to this date, the benefit of notional fixation of pay will be granted. After regularization of the services of petitioner, his pay be fixed notionally and he will be given 50% back wages from the date of Award i.e. 23.12.1994 till realization. After the reinstatement of the petitioner on 22.11.2013, the petitioner will get other pecuniary service benefit as full salary. The payment will be made with interest @ 6%. ”

Learned counsel for the respondent states that Letter Patent Appeal preferred against the order dated 21.09.2018 has been dismissed. He further undertakes that the needful for the compliance of order dated 21.09.2018 shall be done within three weeks from today.

In view of the above, no order is required to be passed in contempt petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued against the respondent is hereby discharged.

The petitioner would be at liberty to revive the present contempt petition, in case the afore-said statement made by the counsel for the respondent is not adhered to.
