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KRISHNA MURARI, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral):

On being confronted with the observation that the remedy of resolution of dispute by negotiations before invoking the arbitration clause since has not been exhausted, this application under section 11(6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, is pre-mature, learned counsel sought leave of the Court to permit withdrawal of the application with liberty to exhaust the said remedy.

Prayer made is allowed.

Application stands dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty prayed for.
