On 07.05.2019, the following order was passed:-

“ On 07.03.2019, the following order was passed:-

Prayer is for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.13 dated 19.1.2018 under Sections 420,465,467,468,120-B IPC and U/s 13 of Punjab Prevention of Human Smuggling Act, 2012, PS Sirhind, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

The petitioner was on bail in the said case but since he had not appeared on 01.10.2018, the learned trial Court cancelled his bail bonds and surety bonds and issued nonbailable warrants against him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the nonappearance of the petitioner was not intentional. During the pendency of the present case, another FIR No.376 dated 04.09.2018 under Sections 420,467,468,471 IPC was registered at P.S City Barnala against the petitioner and thus apprehending his arrest, the petitioner could not cause his appearance before the trial Court . He has since been granted anticipatory bail in the said case. Learned counsel undertakes that the petitioner will appear before the learned trial Court on any date to be fixed by this Court.

Meanwhile, the petitioner may appear before the learned trial Court and on his doing so, he shall be released on interim bail by the trial Court subject to his

furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to its satisfaction.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submit that the petitioner pursuant to the aforesaid order appeared before the trial Court and was released on bail and thereafter, he has been appearing regularly. However, learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to produce the certified copy of the order.

Adjourned to 15.07.2019.”

Learned counsel for the State has submitted that the petitioner Gurinder Singh @ Guri appeared before the Court below and released on bail. She has further placed on file photocopy of the order dated 15.06.2019 when the petitioner was granted exemption from appearance for that day.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, once the petitioner has appeared and released on regular bail, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

Petitioner is directed to keep attending the hearing unless exempted by the Court.
