Petitioner participated in the selection process for the post of Sub Inspector (Female) in the General category pursuant to advertisement dated 16.04.2018 (Annexure P-2). After qualifying the written examination, she appeared for Physical Screening Test.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that when the result was prepared, petitioner had objected, but her objections were not considered.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Palika Monga, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and informs that final result has since been declared on 04.03.2019. She further states that the petitioner can see the CCTV footage of the Physical Screening Test after 15 days. This much time will be taken by the respondent-Commission to get data from the agency, who had done the recording of Physical Screening Test.

In view of the said fact, this petition is disposed of by giving

liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondent-Commission after 15

days of receipt of certified copy of this order and upon doing so, the respondent-Commission will show the CCTV footage of Physical Screening Test to the petitioner, subject to payment of costs of Rs.3000/- as fee for watching the said footage.
