This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.101 dated 22.02.2017 registered under Section 346 IPC (Sections 302, 201, 34 IPC) at Police Station Sadar Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

Counsel for the petitioner argues that similarly situated co-accused was granted the concession of bail vide order dated 05.03.2019 passed in CRM-M-8308-2019. He further argues that in the present case also the petitioner has undergone almost 2 years like that case.

Custody certificate filed in Court dated 12.03.2019 by Anil Kumar, Dy. Supdt., District Prison, Jhajjar is taken on record. As per the custody certificate, the petitioner has undergone 1 year 11 months and 20 days of custody.

Learned Assistant Advocate General on instructions from ASI Raj Kumar has accepted that the petitioner is similarly situated to that accused.

Keeping in view the entire conspectus of facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny parity to the petitioner. Consequently, I grant regular bail to the petitioner. Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
