Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits, *inter alia*, that after closure of the petitioner/defendants' evidence, the matter is now posted for 27.03.2019 for rebuttal evidence on behalf of the respondent/plaintiff and, if given an opportunity, the petitioners/defendants would be completing their evidence within two effective dates, which can even be consecutive, and shall also be willing to pay appropriate compensatory costs.

2. In the given circumstances, this Court is not inclined to issue any notice to the respondent as such a course would only cause avoidable delay which will not be beneficial to either of the contesting sides.

3. The present revisional petition is, therefore, disposed off with a direction that the Ld. Trial Court shall permit the petitioners/defendants to

complete their evidence either on the next date (already) fixed, or thereafter as convenient to the Court, subject to payment of costs of ₹4,000/- by the petitioners/defendants to the respondent/plaintiff, and also subject to the condition that no further adjournment in favour of the petitioners' evidence thereafter shall be allowed.
