As per pleadings on record, petitioner was allotted the handling and transport tender at Jandiala Centre for a period of two years vide allotment letter dated 08.01.2019 issued by the Food Corporation of India.

The short grievance raised in the instant petition is that the petitioner who otherwise belongs to Balachaur, District SBS Nagar and respondent No.5 who is the Secretary of the Food Allied Workers Union, Jandiala, which is operating at Railhead Jandiala alongwith respondents No. 6 to 9 who happen to be members of the Union are threatening the petitioner with dire consequences and rather preventing him from execution of the contract allotted in his favour.

Having perused the pleadings on record and having heard submission advanced by counsel, instant writ petition is disposed of in terms of issuance of directions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) Amritsar, to examine the grievance of the petitioner

against the backdrop of a representation dated 01.03.2019 (Annexure P-2) which is stated to have already been submitted and to thereafter take steps as he deems fit and as warranted in accordance with law.
