Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.169 dated 30.09.2018 under Sections 323, 341, 506, 379-B, 295-A, 27, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Haibowal, Police District Commissionerate Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 08.03.2019: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the FIR is registered on account of a case of road rage and as per the FIR, the petitioner was not present at the time when the minor accident had taken place and he came later on, when scuffle took place between his brother and the complainant.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the

aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Harmesh Lal, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 08.03.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
