ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.94 dated 16.04.2018 under Sections 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Maloya, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that she has accepted a sum of Rs.2.00 lac as earnest money for the sale of her house from the complainant. The house allegedly did not belong to the petitioner. In terms of the interim order passed by this Court on 23.08.2018, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner she has joined the investigation. He also states that the petitioner has deposited a sum of Rs.2.00 lac with the registry of this Court as directed by the Coordinate Bench vide order dated 25.03.2019.

Learned counsel on instructions from ASI Ashwani Kumar states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for further interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner having joined investigation and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 23.08.2018, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
