The grievance raised in this case is that the sale deed in favour of Sunita wife of Lokesh Kumar was not being registered.

Mr. Hawa Singh Bhambu, Naib Tehsildar-cum-Joint Registrar, Rai, District Sonapat is present in Court and submits his unconditional apology and states that the petitioner has not approached with the sale deed, requisite stamp papers and witnesses. The stand taken, prima facie, is not acceptable.

At this stage, learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in case, the petitioner approaches the office of the respondent on any Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday from 9.00 AM to 5.00 PM, needful would be done expeditiously.

The petitioner shall approach the respondent on 29.11.2019 at 11.00 AM with the drafted sale deed, the respondent shall give in writing the required stamp papers and documents needed.

The petitioner undertakes that thereafter, he will appear on 04.12.2019 at 11.00 AM taking along with him all the requisite documents etc. The respondent undertakes to do the needful on 04.12.2019, itself.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of.
