Through this petition, the petitioner sought quashing of order dated 15.2.2019 (Annexure P-4) passed by learned Sessions Judge, Moga vide which the application of the petitioner for transfer of criminal complaint No.4/2017 dated 20.7.2017 filed under Sections 494, 109, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code to some other court of competent jurisdiction at Moga has been dismissed.

The transfer application was moved basically on two grounds; firstly, an application under Section 311 of the Code of Criminal Procedure was dismissed by learned Presiding Officer and secondly, the respondent wife has stated that she has personal acquaintance with the Judicial Officer as the latter is having parental house at Khanna and the wife of said Presiding Officer is a teacher.

To the mind of this Court, none of the grounds is acceptable for the purpose of transfer of the case. The impugned order does not suffer from any illegality, irregularity and infirmity.

Dismissed.
