AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 28.11.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.26945 of 2018.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:-

“Petition is hereby disposed of with the direction that in case petitioner sends a fresh copy of the legal notice/representation to the concerned authority alongwith a copy of this order by registered/speed post, the authority shall pass a speaking order at the earliest, in any case not later than six weeks of receipt thereof. If any amount is found due to the petitioner, payment of same be released after sanction from the Finance Department, if required.”

Learned counsel for the respondents has filed reply today in the Court annexing order dated 15.07.2019, same is taken on record. Copy of reply is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that no cause of action survives to pursue the contempt petition. However, liberty be granted to him to avail remedies in accordance with law, if aggrieved of order dated 15.07.2019.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty to the petitioner, as prayed for.

The rule issued against the respondents is discharged.
