Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.531 dated 10.12.2018, registered at Police Station Sector 17/18, District Gurugram, under Section 20 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Heard.

As per the FIR, 24 kg *ganja patti* has been recovered from the petitioner, whereas learned counsel for the petitioner states that while dismissing the bail application of the petitioner on 16.02.2019 by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurugram, it has been written that 24 kg poppy leaves had been recovered.

Learned State counsel very fairly states that out of 11 prosecution witnesses, 4 witnesses have been examined.

The petitioner has already undergone for a period of about one year. The trial of the case would take time to conclude. Therefore, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final dispose of the case.

Without commenting anything on the merits lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court/Duty Magistrate.
