The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the appellate Court to discharge the petitioner from conviction as awarded by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ferozepur vide judgement dated 13.3.2018 in a complaint under Section 138 Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

A perusal of the petition reveals that against the judgement of conviction and order of sentence dated 13.3.2018, an appeal bearing No.CRA/52/2018 stands preferred before the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ferozepur and the same is pending.

Once the petitioner has availed the statutory remedy of appeal, this Court does not find any reason to issue any directions as prayed for. No ground is made out for invoking the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Dismissed.
