This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.35 dated 23.07.2018 registered under Sections 302/506/34 IPC at Police Station Qadian, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur, Punjab with a further prayer to direct the summoning Court to accept the bail bonds of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that the persons who were actually attributed the injuries have been arrested. The petitioners were only shown to be present and no overt act was attributed to them in the FIR nor does the MLR indicate that any injury which may have been caused by the petitioners.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from ASI Satnam Singh has accepted that three persons to whom injuries have been attributed have been arrested.

In the circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Resultantly, the petition is allowed.

The petitioners are directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on the next date to face the trial and the Court shall release them on bail to its satisfaction.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
