Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.24 dated 17.03.2018 under Sections 354-B, 323 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Kot Ise Khan, District Moga and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise arrived at between the petitioners and respondent No.2.

Vide order dated 05.09.2018, this Court had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate within a period of one month so as to get their statements recorded in support of compromise.

Vide subsequent order dated 02.11.2018, the parties were again directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court to get their statements recorded in support of compromise. Thereafter, on 01.04.2019, none had put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners and the case was

adjourned to 29.04.2019. Even on 29.04.2019, no one had appeared on behalf of the petitioners and the case was adjourned for today.

A communication dated 05.01.2019 has been received from the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Moga stating therein that neither on 03.12.2018 i.e. the date fixed nor thereafter, the parties appeared before that Court to get their statements recorded in support of compromise.

It seems that either the petitioners have lost interest in pursuing the present petition or the compromise between the parties has not been materialized.

The present petition is, accordingly, dismissed for non-prosecution.
