Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in view of the order passed by this Court in CWP No.2866 of 2014, the petitioners are entitled for re-fixation of their pension as per the circular dated 15.12.2011 and other circulars issued by the Government from time to time.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that after the judgment was rendered by this Court, the petitioners have even issued a legal notice on 09.10.2018 (Annexure P-5) claiming the said benefit but despite the lapse of approximately four months, no benefit has been extended to the petitioners as directed by this Court in CWP No.2866 of 2014 decided on 30.09.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further states that the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 09.10.2018 (Annexure P-5) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioners for the relief which has been claimed by them in the legal notice dated 09.10.2018 (Annexure P-5), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 09.10.2018 (Annexure P-5) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
