RA-CR No.24 of 2019 and **RA-CR No.24 of 2019**.

2. No grounds are made out for condonation of delay of 51 days in filing the review application, nor for review of the original order dated 10.12.2018, passed by this Court.

3. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners has, in all fairness, admitted that there is no impropriety or infirmity in the said order dated 10.12.2018, but submits that after the eviction order against the petitioners has become final, they now want to vacate the demised shop and would be willing to shift to any of the two adjacent shops owned by the respondent/landlord, and have, therefore, approached this Court with a hope that some good may come out of this offer.

4. Undoubtedly, the present applications are a means to misuse the Court's process with a view to cause further delay/harassment to the respondents' side.

5. The present applications are, therefore, dismissed along with imposition of costs of ₹2,000/- upon the applicants/petitioners for having wasted the Court's valuable time. The costs imposed shall be deposited in

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the Office of the Member Secretary, Punjab Legal Services Authority,
within a fortnight from today.

6. In view of dismissal of **RA-CR No.24 of 2019**, the stay
application, being **CM No.5627-CII of 2019**, also stands dismissed.
