This application has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for correction and modification of order dated 10.05.2019 as it has been passed inadvertently in present case, instead of connected case i.e.CRM-M-811-2016.

The order dated 10.05.2019 is recalled as it was inadvertently passed in the present petition instead of CRM-M-811-2016 (connected case).

CRM-M-18158-2014

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing of FIR No.546 dated 27.12.2011, under Sections 406 and 420 IPC (Section 120-B IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Ambala City, District Ambala.

In CRM-M-32728-2014, vide order dated 10.05.2019, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court for recording of their statements and report was sought regarding compromise.

In deference to the said order, a report dated 18.05.2019 submitted by the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Ambala which reveals that as per statements made by the parties in the Court, they have voluntarily entered into a compromise and the Court is satisfied that the said settlement is without any fear, pressure, threat or coercion and out of their free will. It is also reported that petitioner has not been declared as proclaimed offender.

In view of the compromise effected between the parties, statements of complainant as well as petitioners in CRM-M-32728-2014 have been recorded regarding compromise, present petition succeeds and FIR No.546 dated 27.12.2011 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Ambala City, District Ambala and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are ordered to be quashed.

Petition is allowed.
