[1] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that in view of the petitioners not having made a demand to the respondents in respect of the grievance, which is the subject matter of the writ petition, the writ petition be disposed of at this stage by granting liberty to the petitioners to make a representation to the respondents within 02 weeks from today and respondents be directed to consider and decide the same, in accordance with law on receipt of the representation.

[2] In view of the innocuous nature of the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by granting liberty to the petitioners to make a representation to respondent No.2 within 02 weeks from today and on receipt of representation within the stipulated period, respondent No.2 shall consider and decide the same in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 02 months thereafter from the date of receipt of the representation.
