Petitioner Kashmir Kaur has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect life and liberty of her and her family members, who are being harassed by respondent No.4-SHO Police Station Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran.

Status report by way of affidavit of Sulakhan Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Valtaha, Camp at Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran already stands filed. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh apprised the Court that an FIR No.272 dated 01.12.2017, under Section 22 of NDPS Act has been

registered at Police Station Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran against Lakha Singh (husband of petitioner) and the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. was submitted before the Court on 05.12.2018.

At this stage, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner states that in view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed off as such.
