AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner that land of the petitioner was acquired, out of which some of the land has been released from acquisition. He filed an application under the Right to Information Act and in pursuance thereof, the said information has been supplied to him. The details thereof are mentioned in Annexure P-4. The grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner has apprehension that the land which has been released to the petitioner from acquisition is being handed over to the private respondents. He contends that in case the land of the petitioner is not released, he be paid the compensation thereof and if it has been so released, the said land be demarcated and possession delivered back to him. Putting forth this grievance, petitioner has filed a representation dated 04.09.2015 (Annexure P-6) and thereafter another representation dated 04.12.2018 (Annexure P-7) which has been submitted to respondents 2, 3 and 4 i.e. the Deputy Commissioner-cum-Collector, Panipat, Tehsildar, Panipat, Tehsil and District Panipat and the Land Acquisition Collector, HUDA, Panipat, but no action has been taken on the said representations.

2. Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to these respondents to consider

and decide his representation dated 04.12.2018 (Annexure P-7) at an early date.

3. Without going into merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to respondents 2, 3 and 4 i.e. the Deputy Commissioner-cum-Collector, Panipat, Tehsildar, Panipat, Tehsil and District Panipat and the Land Acquisition Collector, HUDA, Panipat, to consider and decide the representation dated 04.12.2018 (Annexure P-7) of the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case the claim of the petitioner, as projected therein, is accepted, the demarcation of the land be carried out and the possession thereof be handed over to the petitioner within a further period of one month.
