The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.16 dated 04.02.2019, under Sections 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, and Section 24 of Immigration Act, 1924, registered at Police Station Dugri, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he had taken money to send the wife of the complainant to Canada. He further contends that the matter has been compromised. He has brought a demand draft in the name of the complainant for an amount of Rs.2,50,000/- in Court, which has been handed over to learned counsel for the complainant and another sum of Rs.2,50,000/- shall be given to the complainant at the time of recording the statement in terms of the compromise. He also contends that vide order

dated 08.03.2019 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant contends that the matter has indeed been compromised by the parties.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kapil Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the matter has been compromised and the petitioner has joined the investigation, interim order dated 08.03.2019 granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
