As per pleadings on record the petitioner is running a petrol pump under the name of Jwalamukhi Filling Station, Chandigarh Road, Balachaur.

Counsel submits that the respondent National Highways Authority of India issued a notification for widening of the four lane on the Phagwara to Rupnagar stretch and accordingly some land under the ownership of the petitioner was also acquired and for which compensation had been paid.

The short grievance raised in the petition is that by virtue of acquisition of the land, construction work has commenced right in front of the petrol pump and the National Highway Authority of India has not even left any access to the petrol pump from the highway and thereby the sales have dried up.

In the light of the grievance raised in the petition and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the same in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach the National Highways Authority of India for redressal of his grievance.
