MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of pre arrest bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.264 dated 14.10.2018, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 325, 307 and 452 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC'), registered at Police Station Sadar Narwana, District Jind.

While issuing notice of motion, this Court passed the following order on 11.03.2019 :-

“Contends that although the petitioners were arrested on 30.10.2018 and 25.10.2018 respectively and thereafter, they were released on bail, but on account of an opinion dated 26.11.2018 by a private doctor, Section 307, IPC has been added and both the petitioners apprehending their arrest. Also contends that petitioners are ready to join the investigation.

Notice of motion for 11.04.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of their

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arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit them to interim bail in the present case till the next date of hearing on their furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioners are also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Raj Kumar has acknowledged that in terms of the previous order, the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no longer required in this case.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 11.03.2019 is made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the present petition is disposed off.
