Vide this judgment, I shall be disposing of six petitions bearing CRM-M Nos.19230, 21905, 23708, 26498, 35026 and 17937 of 2018. Counsel for the parties are also agreed that all these petitions can be conveniently disposed of by a common judgment.

It is not disputed by the State counsel that the petitioners in all the cases have already joined the investigation. The complainant claims that this agreement to sell has been got executed with a view to defraud him. The agreement to sell is in writing and the complainant has signed in

English whereas the agreement to sell is scribed in Hindi. Still further, the intended seller has filed a suit for rescission of the contract which was withdrawn whereas the complainant has filed a suit for cancellation of this very agreement.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the interim protection granted to the petitioners, in all the petitions, is made absolute.

All the petitions are allowed.
