Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6 as they have solemnized marriage against the wishes of private respondents.

Learned State counsel apprised the Court that the statements of petitioner No.1 and respondent No.4 have been recorded and same have been filed in the Court which are taken on record. Respondent No.5 i.e. mother of petitioner No.2 has expired. Copy thereof has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioners. In the statements of petitioner No.1, it is stated petitioners are living together happily and they have no threat as on today whereas in the statement of respondent No.4, it is stated that he has no objection to the alleged marriage of the petitioners. This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioners.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the petition.
