The present contempt petition has been filed pleading willful disobedience of the order dated 08.10.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 25860 of 2018. The operational part of the order is reproduced below:-

“Without making any comments on the merits of the petitioners' claim, the present petition is disposed off at this stage with a direction upon respondent Nos.1 and 2 to respond to the petitioners' legal notice dated 11.04.2018 (Annexure P-7) with speaking decisions within three months from the date of communication of this order, and in case the petitioners are found entitled to payment of any dues as claimed, the same be disbursed to them within three months thereafter.”

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the order of this

Court has been complied with and placed on record a copy of order dated

01.07.2019 passed in compliance of order dated 08.10.2018, the same is taken on record. Copy thereof, has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioner.

In view of above, no cause of action survives in the present contempt petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

The petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law in case he is still aggrieved of the order dated 01.07.2019.
