AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 07.09.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.22745 of 2018.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:-

“3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in legal notice (P-7) and to take a conscious decision in accordance with law, rules and regulations, particularly in view of judgment referred to above in para 1 of this order, which as per the version of learned counsel for the petitioners has attained finality, within a period of four months

from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioners still feel aggrieved by any order of the aforesaid authority, they shall be at liberty to have recourse to the remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.”

Learned counsel for the respondent has produced copy of order dated 25.03.2019, same is taken on record. Copy of order is supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of said order, learned counsel for the petitioner states that no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition.

The contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.

The petitioner has already been granted liberty by the Writ Court to avail remedies available in accordance with law, if grievance survives.
