It is not disputed that entire payment has been made in full and final settlement of the claim. Offence under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act is compoundable.

Hon'ble the Supreme Court in the case of **K.M. Ibrahim Vs. K.P. Mohammed and another, (2010) 1 SCC 798** has permitted compounding at the stage of special leave petition.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court allows parties to compound the offence and set aside the judgments of the Courts below and acquit the petitioner of the charges leveled against him.

Accordingly, the present criminal revision petition is allowed.
