Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 126 dated 29.11.2016, registered under Sections 307, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC, Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur.

Vide order dated 20.1.2017, the petitioner was granted interim bail. Thereafter the present petition was dismissed for non-prosecution vide order dated 10.9.2019. The said order was recalled vide order dated 3.12.2019 and the petition was restored to its original number and the petitioner was give final opportunity to join the investigation and cooperate with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harbhajan Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated

20.1.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
