Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.2 and 3 not to harass the petitioners at the behest of respondents No.4 to 7 and with a further direction to respondents No.4 to 7 not to interfere in the married life of petitioners.

In pursuance to the notice of motion order, both the petitioners as well as parents of petitioner No.1 namely Gopinath Verma (father of petitioner No.1), Rajwanti Devi (mother of petitioner No.1), Santosh and Sunil (brothers of petitioner No.1) are present in the Court.

The case was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for their counselling and for recording their statements.

Petitioner No.1 namely Kajal has stated that she has performed marriage with petitioner No.2 knowingly that he is a widower and is having 03 children.

Similar statement has been made by petitioner No.2 – Vijay

Kumar.

The parents and brothers of petitioner No.1 have stated that they are not interfering in the married life of petitioner No.1 and both the petitioners will be responsible for their decision, act and conduct. It is further stated that they have no objection if petitioner No.1 stays with petitioner No.2.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to approach respondent No.3 i.e the SHO, Police Station Focal Point, District Ludhiana, in case, they still feel any threat to their life and liberty.
