Learned counsel for the petitioner was neither present on earlier two dates of hearings nor today.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kabul Singh submits that though the petitioner has joined investigation but he has not cooperated in the investigation. Two more cases *i.e.* one under NDPS Act and another under Sections 392/395 IPC, are also there against him and he is on bail in one of said cases. Warrants of arrest were issued against the petitioner and PO proceedings have also been initiated against him but still he has not appeared before the Court.

Keeping in view the past conduct of the petitioner and the fact that he has not cooperated with the investigating agency, no ground is made out to release the petitioner on anticipatory bail.

Present petition stands dismissed accordingly.
