The present appeal has been filed by the insurance company against the award dated 01.10.1994, passed by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Rohtak (for short, the Tribunal), vide which, compensation of ₹60,000/- was awarded.

It is stated that the compensation awarded by the Tribunal has already been paid by the insurance company. The appeal is filed on the ground that licence was a fake licence. The owner and driver were proceeded against ex-parte. Even here, the appellant has not been able to serve them till date. In any case, no evidence was led qua the fake licence.

In these circumstances, no useful purpose would be met in pursuing with the present appeal, involving petty amount.

Dismissed accordingly.
