TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.(ORAL)

Petitioner seeks a mandamus for directing the Board of School Education Haryana, to carry out the following corrections in the 12th class certificate i.e. (i) name of the petitioner to read as Mukesh Dutt Sharma instead of Mukesh Dutt; (ii) father's name to read as Suresh Dutt Sharma instead of Suresh Dutt; (iii) date of birth to be entered as 12.05.1992 instead of 15.08.1993.

Counsel at the very outset makes a statement that he would confine the prayer and scope of the instant petition only with regard to correction of the name of the petitioner and his father and does not press the instant petition qua correction in the date of birth.

As per statement made by counsel, instant petition with regard to correction in the date of birth of the petitioner is dismissed.

In the light of such limited prayer and without even ascertaining the correctness of averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to

file a representation to the respondent-Board, confined to the extent of seeking correction of his name as also his father's name in the 12th class certificate.

In the eventuality of any such representation being preferred within a period of 4 weeks from today, the respondent-Board of School Education Haryana, would be obligated to deal with the same in accordance with law and as per byelaws/instructions issued by the Board itself on the subject.

Disposed of.
