Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.02 dated 03.01.2019 under Sections 452, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC was added later on), registered at Police Station Rangar Nangal, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

While granting interim bail to petitioners No.1 & 2, following order was passed by this Court on 27.03.2019: -

“Counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, submits that since petitioner No.3- Ranbir Singh @ Rana and the non-applicant/accused – Sandeep Singh, have already surrendered on 16.03.2019 before the police authorities, this petition may be dismissed as withdrawn qua petitioner No.3.

Ordered accordingly.

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the

petitioners No.1 and 2 namely Mandeep Kaur and Sardool Singh in FIR No.02 dated 03.01.2019 under Sections 452, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Rangar Nangal, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Counsel for petitioners No.1 and 2 has submitted that main allegations are against the co-accused, who have already surrendered before the police authorities.

Notice of motion for 24.04.2019.”

SI Vijay Mohan has submitted that in pursuance of the order dated 27.03.2019, petitioners No.1 & 2 have joined the investigation and are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to petitioners No.1 & 2 vide order dated 27.03.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
