The challenge in the present writ petition is to Annexure P-4 i.e. the order dated 28.04.2016 by which the late husband of the petitioner, who was working as a Sub Inspector in Punjab Roadways, was removed from the service.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that against the said order, the husband of the petitioner had filed an appeal to the higher authorities, which appeal has been appended as Annexure P-5 in the present writ petition. The said appeal was filed on 14.07.2016. After filing the appeal, the husband of the petitioner unfortunately died in September, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the appeal filed by the late husband of the petitioner is still pending consideration with the respondents. He further states that though vide Annexure P-6, a request was made by the petitioner requesting the authorities to decide the appeal, but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.1 to decide the appeal dated 14.07.2016 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the late husband of the petitioner challenging the order of punishment dated 29.04.2016.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by her in the appeal dated 14.07.2016 (Annexure P-5), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.1 to decide the said appeal Annexure P-5 within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
