MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of pre arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.10 dated 21.02.2019, under Sections 307, 323, 341 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Badali Ala Singh District Fatehgarh.

This Court passed the following order on 08.03.2019:-

“Contends that as per the allegations in the FIR only lalkara has been attributed to the petitioner.

Notice of motion returnable by 18.03.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

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Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Major Singh, has acknowledged that in terms of the previous order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required in this case.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 08.03.2019 is made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the present petition is disposed off.
