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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This is a petition filed for grant of bail in case FIR No. 189, dated 28.10.2018, registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar Rural.

The allegation in FIR is that the petitioner was found in possession of 870 loose tablets of peach colour.

As per FSL report, total weight of Aplrazolam is 100.92 grams which is non commercial.

The learned State counsel states that investigation in case is complete and trial has commenced.

Petitioner is in custody since 31.1.2019. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of present case; without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

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However, if petitioner indulges in any activity of similar nature,
while on bail, prosecution agency will be at liberty to seek cancellation of
order granting bail to petitioner.
