Report dated 15.1.2019 of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri has been received after recording statements of accused Vishal as well as complainant Renu Bala and the learned court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise is an outcome of voluntariness, free will and without any coercion or undue pressure. In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and in view of the fact that compromise will go a long way in resolving the personal dispute and to bring about

personal harmony and would be for the betterment of future lives of the parties and in view of the law laid down in **Gian Singh vs State of Punjab and another, 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs State of Punjab and another, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052** and in view of which the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 821 dated 25.5.2017 registered at Police Station Jagadhari City, District Yamuna Nagar under sections 354-D, 506 IPC and all consequences arising thereof are quashed, qua the present petitioner.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
