GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

The petitioner has approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.108 dated 4.11.2017 registered at Police Station Kot Dharmu, District Mansa under Sections 279, 337 and 427 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, wherein offence under Section 338 IPC was added later on and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 15.3.2019, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Mansa has been received, wherein it has been reported that statements of petitioner/accused

Parvinder Singh @ Parminder Singh and also of complainant Kaur Singh and Baldev Singh have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves out of their sweet will and without any pressure.

The learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Mansa has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.108 dated 4.11.2017 registered at Police Station Kot Dharmu, District Mansa under Sections 279, 337 and 427 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, wherein offence under Section 338 IPC was added later on and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioner.
